Job Description:

Our riverboat The *Explorer* has taken out thousands of people on the Blackstone River. Our goal is to promote the environmental wellbeing of the Blackstone River, as it is one of the most heavily polluted rivers in the U.S. In conjunction with educators from Mystic Aquarium we take out all ages on the river, from first graders to seniors. Our goal is to teach them about pollution, environmental stewardship, history, and the wildlife we have here on the river.

We are looking for a Boat Hand to work at least ten hours a week, which can increase due to schedule. Pay will go up to \$15 an hour. We are looking specifically for someone interested in getting sea time hours on the river in pursuit of their captain's license or a career at sea.

Responsibilities

- Preparing the boat for launch each day. Includes cleaning, preparing machinery and navigational equipment, refilling fuel, etc.
- Assisting in setting up and organizing materials needed for the day, such as life jackets for passengers
- Assisting captains with whatever they might need for the day
- Learning appropriate boat safety protocol as well as running several boat safety drills with our captains.
- Ensuring passenger safety on board
