The Partnership will be working extensively in the city of Providence where the poverty rate includes 21% of the population, with a focus on the North End/Ward 4 community. The Partnership's targeted co-design approach will help alleviate poverty in the region by designing an outdoor space that builds upon the strengths and assets of the neighborhood.

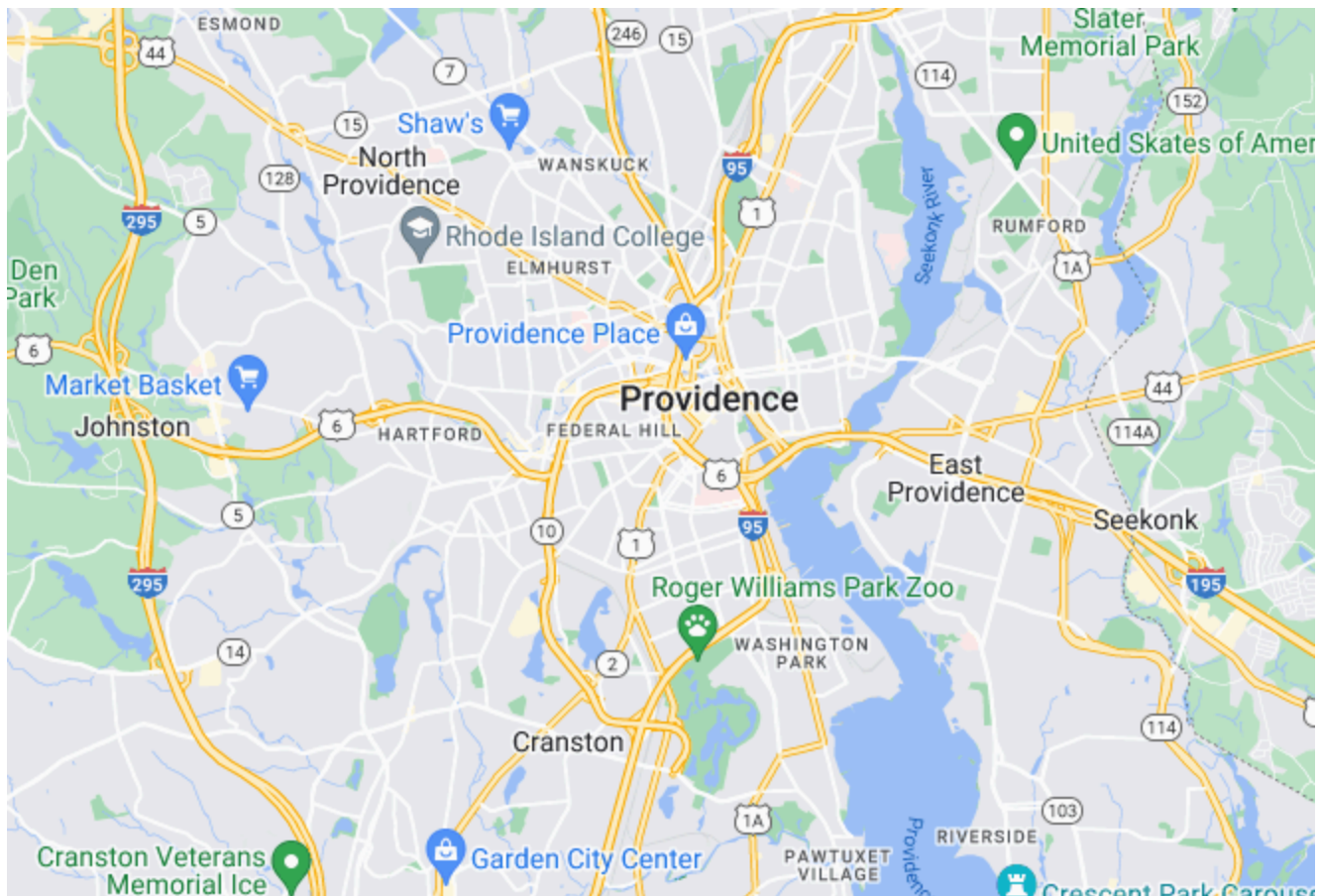
